The Massachusetts Construction Supervisors (MACS) Candidate's Bulletin for the new Computer Based Testing (CBT)—no computer experience or typing skill required--beginning May 1, 2005, and later can be reviewed on two websites as follows:

Receiving License: If a passing score was earned, instructions for obtaining the license will be received on the Score Report. The \$150.00 fee for the license **must be received within one year** from the date of the exam at the State Board of Building Regulations and Standards—One Ashburton Place, RM 1301, Boston, MA 02108. The full name must be typed or legibly printed on the bank check or money order; no personal checks will be accepted by the Board. Failure to comply with these regulations may require re-examination.

Processing of a license should be completed within 30 to 60 days of receipt of the request.
